Program

Day 1 – April 13 (Sat) ARRIVAL IN PORTO / SUNSET CRUISE & DINNER

Meals included: dinner

Group transfer from Porto airport to your hotel.

3:00 PM Check-in at 4-star Oca Flores Hotel in the city center, within walking distance

of major attractions, dining, and shopping

5:30 PM Meet Sam and our local guide for an orientation talk in the lobby of the

hotel

6:00 PM Walk down to Ribeira Pier for a Sunset Cruise on the River Douro.
7:30 PM Group welcome dinner at Restaurante Traça, in the heart of the city





Day 2 – April 14 (Sun)

PORTO – WALKING TOUR

Meals included: Breakfast; light snack

9:30 AM

Walking tour of Ribeira and the old town. A three-hour walk through the neighborhood of Ribeira and downtown Porto will take us to the city's main attractions. We will pass historical monuments such as the Church of S. Francisco, the Cathedral, and S. Bento Station. We will walk through the city's medieval streets, discover the streets with the most commerce. During the tour we will stop for a traditional snack

As an option, we can visit Livraria Lello, one of Europe's most famous and beautiful bookstores. (On site ticket purchase required)

Free time to explore the city, shop or just relax in our hotel's panoramic garden.

Dinner on your own. We will be available for restaurant suggestions.

Day 3 – April 15 (Mon) PORTO & WOW MUSEUMS

Meals included: Breakfast; Port Wine tasting

10:00 AM Private transfer from your hotel to the WOW Museums. Guided visit and

entrance fee to 2 museums: World of Wine and The Cork Planet. We will organize both visits in the morning, and then there's free time for lunch in one of the nearby restaurants and visiting other museums and shops. The WOW Museum is a cultural quarter with seven museums, eight

restaurants, interesting shops, and great views.

After lunch: Visit a Port wine lodge, including Port wine tasting.

Later on walk back to the hotel, take the cable car up and cross the upper

trail of the bridge; or take a water taxi to the Porto side.

Dinner on your own and/or option to join a "dutch" dinner organized by Sam at one of the restaurants on the shore of the river, on the Gaia side of Porto.

Day 4 – April 16 (Tue) HEADING TO DOURO

Meals included: Breakfast, Wine Tasting, Lunch, Dinner

Breakfast and checkout

9:30 AM After a few days exploring the city, we will head off to the Douro Valley.

11:30 AM The first stop will be at a wine estate that produces Vinho Verde. Vinho

Verde is a refreshing, light, and slightly effervescent white wine from the Minho region in northern Portugal. Its name literally means "green wine," but it refers to the youthfulness of the wine, not its color. Vinho Verde is usually made from a blend of local grape varieties. It's a great choice for a lively and easy-drinking wine. Guided tour to the vineyards and the winery + 3 wines tasting paired with regional products (vegetarian option available).

12:00 PM Traditional lunch served next to the winery, paired with two wines from the

producer.

1:30 PM Departure to our charming Quinta located next to the River Douro, next to

Pinhão village. On our way, one last stop at the small town of Sabrosa, to see the

house where Fernão de Magalhães (Magellan) was born.

3:30 PM Expected arrival time to our hotel. Check-in and time to relax, before

gourmet dinner at the Quinta, overlooking the River Douro Four nights stay at Douro Valley, UNESCO World Heritage Site.

7:00 PM Dinner at Quinta de la Rosa.



Day 5 – April 17 (Wed)

THE DOURO VALLEY

Meals included: Breakfast, Wine Tasting, Lunch with wine pairing, and Aperitif

9:30 AM

The *Quinta*, where we are staying, is also a very good producer of Douro wine. After breakfast, we will visit the winery and aging cellar (no tasting included).

After the cellar tour, we will head to one of the beautiful villages in the region to visit another wine estate. During this visit, we will see the vineyards and learn the tricks to make the vineyard more ecological, as well as the entire process of the grape from the vine to the glass. Traditional lunch with wine paired with the producer's wines.

The day will end with a 1-hour private cruise on the Douro River, enjoying an aperitif. The cruise starts and ends at Pinhão, a small town next to our hotel. There are several options for dinner on your own in Pinhão. Our Quinta is a short 8-10-minute taxi ride away from town.







Day 6 - April 18 (Thu)

DOURO – 4X4 ADVENTURE

Breakfast, picnic lunch, Bread Tasting and Wine Tasting.

9:20 AM

Transportation to Pinhão train station for a short 15-minute scenic train ride. 4x4 jeeps will be waiting for us for an off-road day, visiting vineyards, learning about Douro wines and grapes, enjoying the views, and visiting traditional bakeries.

We will also taste another of Douro's sweet wines, the Favaios wine. Picnic lunch during the tour.

The tour will end at our hotel.

Dinner on your own in Pinhao. We will be available for restaurant suggestions.





Day 7 - April 19 (Fri) DOURO - TRADITIONAL VILLAGES

Breakfast, lunch and Sparkling wine tasting

10:30 AM On the last day in Douro Valley, we propose a free morning to relax on the

Quinta.

Mid morning, depart to discover a few more local villages and visit a sparkling wine cellar, including tasting. During this tour, we will travel on a section of two of the most iconic Portuguese roads: the EN 2 and the EN 222

and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

Dinner on your own. We will be available for restaurant suggestions.



Day 8 – April 20 (Sat) BACK TO PORTO

Meals included: breakfast and dinner

10:00 AM 10:00 am – Departure to Porto.

12:00 PM Expected arrival time at Oca Flores Hotel, in Porto. Leave your luggage with

the concierge (your room will be available at 03:00 PM or ealrier) and enjoy

your last day in Porto.

7:00 PM Dinner: Transfer on our bus to Restaurant O Valentim, located in the

neighboring town of Matozinhos, for a farewell dinner on the restaurant's



rooftop. Traditional and delicious starters, grilled fish as the main dish, and delicious desserts.

Dinner will be paired with wines from other Portuguese Regions: time to meet Alentejo or Dão wines.
