 - Option to fly direct from U.S. to Rome or Milan and travel by train to Florence Santa Maria Novella train station

Today we explore the beautiful Val d'Orcia, in southern Tuscany, where the famous Brunello di Montalcino wine is produced.
 Take a stroll with Sam & Alice in the village of Montalcino. Optional entrance ticket to the fortress and walk on the medieval battlement
 Drive to Castello Tricerchi Winery
 The first winery of the day is Castello Trecerchi where we visit the cellar and enjoy a wine tasting paired with lunch
 Transfer to the ancient abbey of Sant'Antimo, located in an evocative valley surrounded by olive trees and forest. Free time to explore the medieval

3:30 PM Arrive at Poggio Antico, the second winery of the day for a tasting of 3 wines

6:00 PM Return to the hotel
